Deadlines for Admission

Fall 2011: May 1, 2011
Spring 2012: November 1, 2011

Applications are received, admissions interviews held and offers of admission are made throughout the academic year. Prospective students are urged to apply as early as possible. **Note: All required materials found on the check list below must be received before the application deadline in order for an application to be considered complete. Incomplete files will not be considered.**

Application Contents for Master of Theological Studies, Christian Leadership Master's Program, and Master of Divinity

- Completed application.
- Non-refundable application fee of \$50. Make checks payable to The John Leland Center for Theological Studies or complete the credit card authorization form below.
- Three recommendation forms.
- Transcripts. You must request that each institution send an official transcript of academic work.
- Application essays.
- Resume.
- Interview conducted in person or by phone.

Application Instructions

Application Form. Submit a completed application form with the \$50 nonrefundable application fee to the Office of Admissions. Please be sure to include your application essays.

Official Transcripts. Official transcripts from all previous community colleges, colleges, universities, graduate schools and seminaries must be submitted regardless of when you attended, how many hours were earned and whether a degree was granted. The colleges or universities should mail the official transcripts directly to Leland.

Letters of Recommendation. You must provide three letters of recommendation. The letters should come from your pastor or a church official who knows you best, a former professor or professional colleague, and a friend or associate. The Letter of Recommendation form should be provided to the persons that you list in the Letters of Recommendation section of the admission application. Recommendation forms and letters should be submitted by fax and regular mail only. ***Those completing your recommendation should complete the enclosed recommendation form and attach a letter.*** All applicants are responsible for ensuring that your recommenders complete both the form and a letter of recommendation.
