B1102 HEBREW GRAMMAR AND EXEGESIS

Description of the Course:

In the first semester the student studies the grammar of the Hebrew Consonants, the Hebrew Vowels, Syllabification, the Hebrew Nouns, the definite article, the simple conjunction $\text{And} \equiv$, the Hebrew Prepositions, the Hebrew Adjectives, the Hebrew Pronouns, the Construct Chain, and the Qal of the verb.

In the second semester the student learns the derived stems of the Hebrew verb and reviews all the grammar by reading the thirty sections of the graded reader of Biblical Hebrew. He also learns and reviews the basics of Hebrew syntax.
