Purpose: The student of Biblical Hebrew will continue in his or her study of the fundamentals of Biblical Hebrew grammar and syntax. Students will learn to use the Massoretic Text of the Hebrew Bible, to translate the text, and to be able to use the apparatus of *Biblia Hebraica Stuttgartensia* (BHS). Students will read the prose narratives of Genesis and Exodus and apply their knowledge of grammar and syntax to the text, gaining proficiency in interpreting the text on a linguistic basis.
